RULES OF THE DAY - Four Man Ambrose

Maximum handicap for men is 27 and for women is 40

Men off white tees, women off yellow tees

Each women competing adds 2 extra shots to their course handicap
(This being the difference between the men and women's Course Rating)

- All team members tee off each hole
 - Team chooses the shot they are going to use
 - The golfer whose shot is taken is eliminated from participating in the next shot
 - A player is only eliminated for the one shot following his selected shot
 - This process continues up until the ball is holed out with one person being eliminated for each shot, including putts (**ie only three players play each shot except for the tee shot**)
 - All four players tee off the next hole and the elimination process begins again
 - The eliminated player cannot take a practice shot or putt during the time they are eliminated
 - Should a player take a shot or putt during the time they are eliminated such a situation would be handled with a two stroke penalty and would be considered as "taking a practice shot" under the Rules of Golf.
- For example:
- o Peter, John, Ted & Bill tee off the first hole, Peter's drive is selected as the best shot
 - o Peter is eliminated for the next shot and only John, Ted & Bill take the second shot
 - o Bill's second shot is selected as the best shot out of Bill, Ted & John's second shot
 - o Bill is eliminated for the next shot and only Ted, John & Peter putt
 - o Ted, John & Peter each putt, and John's is the closest to the hole
 - o John is eliminated from the next putt, Ted, Bill & Peter putt and Peter sinks the putt
 - o Peter, John, Ted & Bill all tee off the second hole & the elimination process starts again

Three Tee Shots

Each team member's tee shot must be used at least three (3) times per eighteen (18) hole round. The Scorer must record whose tee shot was used on each hole.

Selected shot

The position of the selected shot is marked. Three team members may then place their ball within one club length of the marked position, no nearer the hole, and play from this position. If the selected shot is on the fairway, the fringe of the green or in a hazard, bunker or rough (intermediate or regular) the ball must be placed within one (1) club length of the selected shot, no nearer the hole, and must remain on the fairway, the fringe of the green or in the hazard, bunker or rough (intermediate or regular). In a sand bunker, the sand may be raked prior to any ball being placed.

On the Putting Green

The position of the selected putt is marked. Other team members may then place their ball within one putter head length of the marked position, no nearer the hole, and putt from this position. Once the ball is holed out, no further strokes count.

Scorecard

The scorecard must show each team member's handicap. Add together for total and divide by 8 for your teams handicap. Maximum handicap for men is 27 and women is 40. Men off white tees women off yellow. The scorecard is to be signed by two members of your team.
